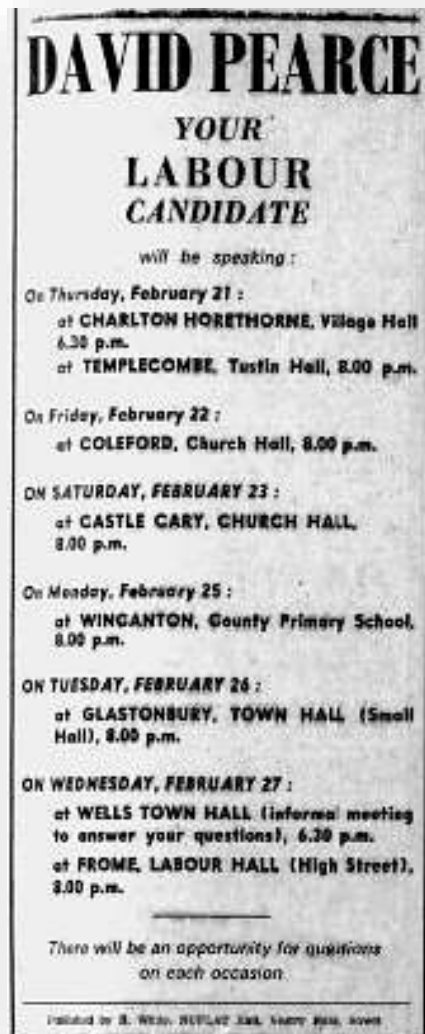

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The February 1974 General Election was held on Thursday 28th February.

The district originally known as Yeovil was formed on 1st April 1974 and adopted the South Somerset name in 1985.

The seat was won in 1974 by John Peyton, Conservative.

The Labour Party, led by Harold Wilson, was 17 seats short of an overall majority.

The result was a hung parliament, the first since 1929, as the Conservatives failed to come to an agreement with the Liberals.

Harold Wilson became Prime Minister for the second time, his first with a minority government.
