

Village vote on sale of hall

NEARLY 100 people attended a special meeting called by Charlton Horethorne village hall committee to vote on a resolution that in the event of new school facilities being provided which were suitable and available for the community, the existing hall and site may be sold to assist the provision of such facilities.

Mr D Jolly presented projected financial requirements and Mr R A Pollard, director of the community council for Somerset, confirmed that such joint facilities were possible.

Questions from the floor covered availability of the proposed new hall, hiring charges and community access in the event of the school being closed.

Mr K Mullins proposed the addition of: "The committee to call another general meeting prior to any final decision being made", and the amended resolution was carried by a majority.
