

Arrangements for the Queen's Silver Jubilee Celebrations 1977

The Queen's Silver Jubilee Celebrations, 1977 - entertainments
and events in Charlton Horethorne village.

1.

May 28 to June 12 inclusive.

Erection, maintainance and removal of street decorations (flags and bunting) on trees, poles and (with permission of occupiers) on private buildings. No decorations across any public highway.

Between June 4 and 8 inclusive.

2. Old Peoples' Party and Music Hall Entertainment.

To be held in the Village Hall with use of all contents, viz: stage and fittings, tables and chairs, kitchen facilities and equipment, and crockery. All on loan, free of charge.

3. Village Sports.

Principally childrens' school sports with a few adult events. To be held on the Primary School playing field.

4. Childrens' Party. Tea and indoor games.

To be held in the Primary School.

5. Barbecue.

To be held in an open space, anticipated to be a field.

6. Carnival.

Street procession of six or seven decorated and manned floats, wheeled vehicles such as bicycles, perambulators, wheelbarrows, etc., and pedestrians. Floats will consist of agricultural trailers drawn by tractors, Land Rovers or the like, and will be on loan together with drivers.

7. Jubilee Ball.

To be held in the Village Hall. Conditions as (2) above.

Insurance Cover

Liability of the Committee for damages for injury to any person or persons engaged in any of the above activities whether as organiser, voluntary helper in any capacity, performer, competitor, spectator or visitor.

Liability of the Committee for loss or damage by fire, theft or accident to any building or its contents, vehicle or other property consequent upon the provision of the above entertainments and events.

Notes.

If necessary to be insured separately against fire, the Village Hall should be covered for £10,000 and its contents for £1,000. It is constructed of wood, with a felted roof.

If necessary to be insured separately, vehicles should be covered for £10,000.

Fire Insurance cover will not be necessary for the Village School.
